DONATION OF PLASTIC BENCH LEGS TO THE CHARLEVILLE RSL SUB BRANCH

Council will donate 2 surplus to requirements plastic park bench legs to the Charleville RSL Sub Branch for the purpose of the building of a slat bench for the 2025 ANZAC Day raffle.

COUNCIL ASSISTANCE APPLICATIONS

Council has approved the Community Assistance Grants, for assistance required up to the 30th of June 2025 (2024-2025 as tabled) for \$3000.00 sponsorship (changes in request to Charleville Fishing Club sponsorship of \$1000.00 and Aqua Ants sponsorship - carnival \$1,000.00 and volunteers \$1,000.00 - totalling \$2,000.00) and \$39,750.00 In Kind.

DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION FOR 697 VALERA VALE ROAD, CHARLEVILLE

A resolution was carried that Murweh Shire Council approves the application for a Development Permit for Reconfiguring a Lot for the creation of an easement to give lot access from a constructed road on land located at 697 Valera Vale Road, Charleville, formally described Lot 2 OR88, Lot 1 OR63 and Lot 1 LO13, subject to a number of conditions*

DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION FOR 724 LANGLO RIVER ROAD, CHARLEVILLE

Resolution carried that Murweh Shire Council approves the application for a Development Permit for Reconfiguring a Lot (1 lot into 3 lots) on land located at 724 Langlo River Road, Charleville, formally described Lot 3 on CP908605, subject to a number of conditions*

PROCUREMENT OF CONTRACTOR (PACKAGE MUSC-5 RED WARD AREA)

Council delegates authority to the Chief Executive Officer to enter into a Contract with Russell's Grader Hire Pty Ltd for April 2024 Flood Restoration Delivery (flood damage works) for Package MuSC-5 on Red Ward, Middle Creek, Black Ward, Balmacarra, Creswell Access and Burrandilla Roads. Resolution carried.

APPOINTMENT OF CONTRACTOR FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF MIXED-USE AMENITIES BLOCK AT CHARLEVILLE SHOWGROUNDS

Resolution carried that Council immediately awards Rebus Rest Rooms a contract to the value of \$541,235 (ex GST) for design and construction of a mixed-use amenities block at the Charleville Showgrounds under Local Buy arrangement LB304.

SUCCESSFUL TENDERER FOR INTERMODAL FREIGHT HUB STUDY

Council has accepted the Tender from 'WSP Australia Pty Ltd' to the value of \$402,860 (ex GST) to conduct the Queensland State Government funded feasibility study and business case for an Inland Ports Precinct in Charleville and Roma, and for the transitioning of future freight from road onto the rail network.

REQUEST FOR SPONSORSHIP BY THE MEATANT DUST DEVILS MOTORBIKE CLUB

Council accepts to provide \$750.00 in sponsorship towards prize money for the 2025 Meatant Dust Devils Motorbike Gymkhana. This is in addition to \$1500.00 in-kind provided through Community Assistance Grants. Resolution carried.

NATIONAL BARREL HORSE ASSOCIATION (NHBA) - SPONSORSHIP APPLICATION

A resolution was carried that Council accepts a request from the Southwest District of the National Barrel Horse Association of Australia to provide Silver Sponsorship to the value of \$500.00.
